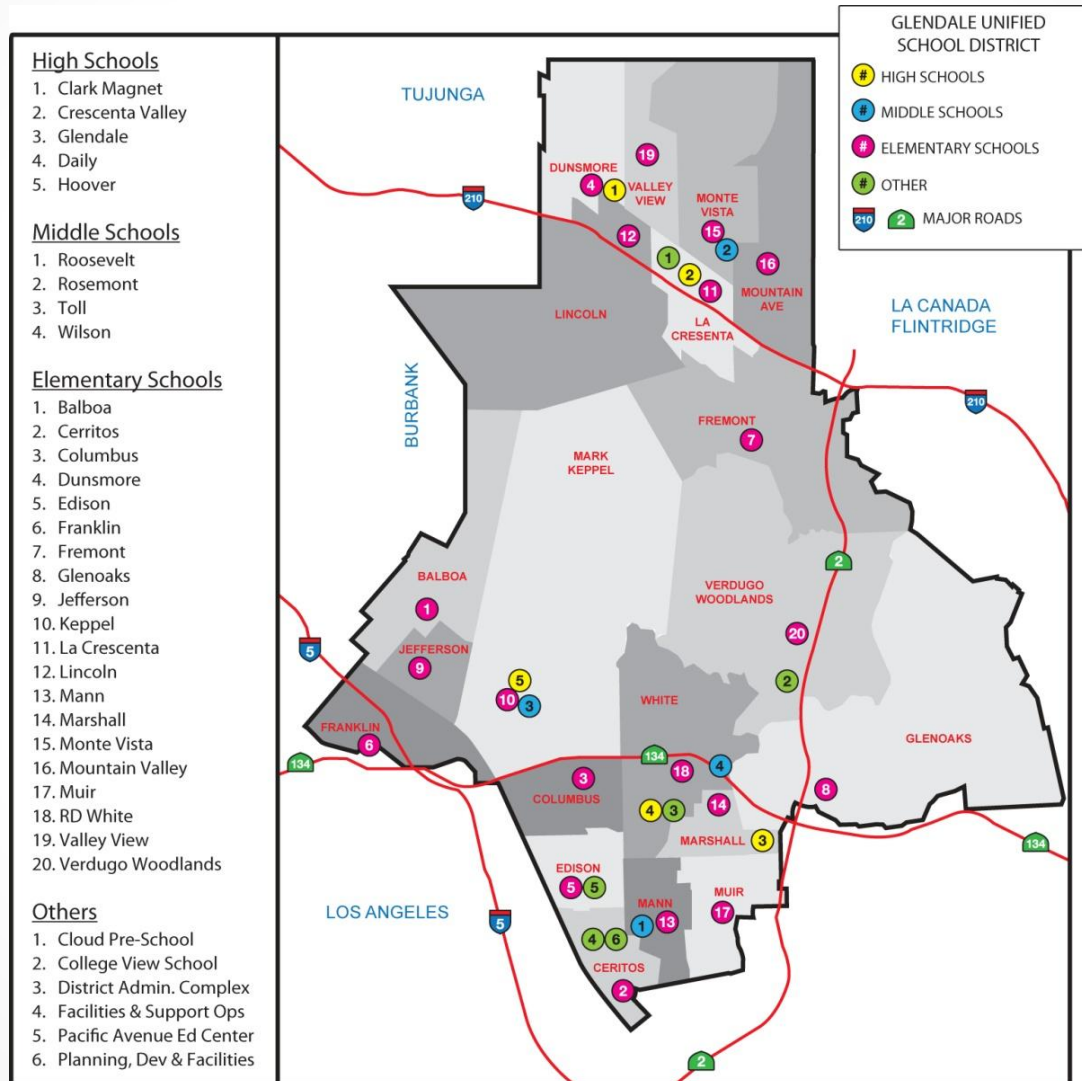
## District Biography

- **Urban School District covering over 32 square miles immediately north and west of the City of Los Angeles**
- **Serve the communities of Glendale, Montrose, La Crescenta, and portions of La Canada.**
- **Unified District with 30 School Locations & 5 Support Facilities**
  - 3 Comprehensive High Schools
  - 1 Science & Technology Magnet High School
  - 1 Continuation High School
  - 4 Middle Schools
  - 20 Elementary Schools
  - 1 Special Education Facility
- **27,000 Student Population**
- **3.2 million square feet of school facilities**

# GLENDALE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

## Past Bond Success

- In 1997 local voters approved Measure K, \$186 million G.O. Bond
- District leveraged \$180 million in State Facilities Program Funds
- Program provided core facilities renovations and infrastructure upgrades
- Total Bond Program of \$366 million was successfully completed six years ahead of schedule and within budget

# GLENDALE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

## Current Bond Program

- In April 2011, local voters approved Measure S, \$270 million G.O. Bond
- Total Measure S Program of \$316 million including other Capital Funds
- Measure S Bond scheduled to be released in issuances of \$54 million over approximately 12 years (under current regulations)

## Current Approved Projects

- **\$26.1 Million Demolition & Reconstruction of College View - Special Education Center**
- **\$19.6 Million in Technology Infrastructure & Equipment Projects**
- **\$10.3 Million for 16 Classroom Replacement Project at Franklin Elementary**
- **\$9.4 Million for Aquatic Center Renovation at Glendale High School**
- **\$9.2 Million of HVAC Renovations at Glendale & Hoover High School**

## Current Approved Projects

- **\$8.3 Million for Phase 1 & 2 Solar Power Installations**
- **\$5.3 Million for Phase 3 & 4 Solar Power Installations**
- **\$5 Million for Science Lab Renovations at Crescenta Valley High School**
- **\$3 Million for District-Wide Security Improvements**
- **\$1.5 Million Annually to continue a Deferred Maintenance Program**
