- Do you have LinkedIn? If not, create an account.

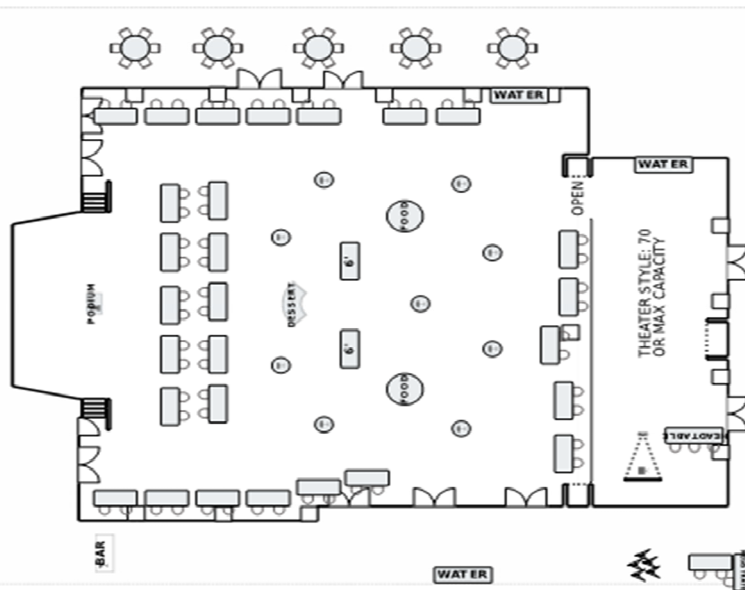
