Project HighlightSR-210 ADA Curb Ramp Upgrades Design Build

California Department of Transportation partnered with Sully-Miller Contracting Co. and AYCE Consulting Engineers, Inc. on the successful delivery of the State Route 210 ADA Curb Ramp Upgrades design-build project. AYCE is the prime design firm, with all design services provided inhouse. The 42-mile long project upgraded 264 existing curb ramps to meet ADA Standards, complete with pavement, signage, striping, electrical, and drainage improvements, in coordination with Caltrans and 14 stakeholder cities. AYCE designed this project in accordance with Caltrans, AASHTO, and ADA standards via a Complete Streets approach.

Founding Story

Kandice Nguyen co-founded AYCE in 2015 to provide services to larger companies, which may be completing mega projects around the country, but could be supplemented with the local knowledge and expertise that Kandice and her team could provide. As a small business owner, she recalls the day she won her first contract: in the afternoon, the AYCE founders were meeting and contemplating giving up, and in the evening she got the call from Arup that they'd won the contract to provide roadway design expertise for UC Merced. Since then, AYCE has grown their contract and client list and continues to strive for repeated clients.






Project Highlight LAWA Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP)

CMTS LLC is providing PMCM services for Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) \$5.5B Landside Access Modernization Program. This program is expected to enhance the traveler's experience and give customers time-certain access to terminals through five congestion-relieving elements:

1) the Automated People Mover (APM), 2) Intermodal Transportation Facility (ITF), 3) Consolidated Rent-A-Car (ConRAC), 4) Roadway Improvements, and 5) Airport Metro Connector Station. The CMTS team has a prime contract and is involved in all five LAMP elements providing construction inspection, risk management, & safety oversight for the PDG.

Founding Story

CMTS was founded by King Harris in Denver, Colorado. The firm's first contract was at Stapleton Airport. In 1989, the company won a major contract as a prime to manage the construction of the new Denver International Airport (DIA). The greenfield project, located on 56sqmi of open prairie, included everything from land acquisition through construction and move-in. At one point on the project, of the more than 500 consultants and staff working on site, more than half were CMTS employees. Over the last three decades, CMTS has expanded to serve clients in Aviation, Infrastructure, Public Works, Transportation, Education, Healthcare, and Sports & Recreational Facilities.

LAWA CTA Smart Park Project: Subconsultant PM & EOR

As part of the Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP), LAWA is implementing a smart parking system and hundreds of EV charging stations in the CTA and at the new LAX Economy Parking structure. Sommer Engineering is responsible for the design of parking lots including: EV infrastructure, constructability review of parking structure plans, and staging for continual parking revenue stream. As an added innovation, Sommer Engineering worked with the CM to test and implement a robotic system to stripe all 4 levels of the 7 garages, resulting in revenue savings and in one week less closure times per garage. This was the first time the robot had been utilized for parking garage striping.

Founding Story

Meridith Cann, PE, saw a gap in the market for SBE/DBE firms that understood the expectations of a major prime firm and major clients, and seeking more flexibility to spend time with her two teenagers, she took the leap and opened her own firm on March 1, 2020. The timing was not ideal - just two weeks later, the country shut down for the COVID-19 pandemic and many planned design jobs were put on hold. However, Sommer Engineering was able to secure its place on a design-build contract for LAWA. Since then, Sommer Engineering has continued to demonstrate its capabilities and finds that relationships are the key to success.

Sommer Engineering has just celebrated its 3-year anniversary.

Fun Fact

Sommer Engineering supports U.S. Veterans by actively seeking to hire veterans.

They have recently hired a U.S. Navy Veteran with a background in Construction Management, who served two tours in Afghanistan. It was there, under the harsh conditions and time limits, he first developed his engineering and construction skills and successfully completed a project that supported front line troops!




