We offer scholarships paid directly to students including seniors. The number and amount of scholarships to be awarded vary from year to year, but typically range between \$2,500 and \$10,000. Some scholarships are specifically for minorities and females.

Include in your statement any hardships or challenges you have or will need to overcome. Conclude your paper on why you should be given an internship and/or scholarship opportunity.

IV. Email application on or before due date with your last name and school name in the email subject line.

V. Confirm delivery on or before the due date.

Condition of receiving an internship or scholarship will require attendance at a CMAA awards ceremony and proof of enrollment at your institution through the Spring 2020 semester.
