SB 169 Authorizes \$2.0 Billion for Student Housing - What Does it Mean for Higher Ed and AEC?

PROGRAM SUMMARY

On September 23, 2021, Governor Newsom signed Senate Bill 169 (SB 169), the postsecondary education budget cleanup trailer bill, which appropriates \$2.0 billion, for the Higher Education Student Housing Grant Program for CSU, UC and CCC systems. The program, with the purpose of providing affordable, low-cost housing options for public postsecondary students in California, will provide one-time grants planning and construction funding. The moderator of this session is a co-leader of development advisory firm Brailsford & Dunlavey's higher education practice, Jeffrey Turner, who will provide an overview of P3 market activity from the firm's annual "State of the Industry Report" and collaborate with panelists to the discuss the following
